
ETYOUR WOOD TO WARKET

Due to saturated wood markets and the pine beetle epidemic, Peak to Peak Wood is offering a unique opportunity to Tree Farmers, Ag-Tax Program participants and other forest landowners to utilize wood coming from your forestry efforts. Peak to Peak Wood – a cooperative effort of Colorado State Parks, the Colorado State Forest Service and five county governments – pays for roundwood cut to specification.

Contractors and landowners are paid at least \$10 a cord to bring roundwood cut at specification to biomass collection sites and sort yards in Larimer, Boulder and Gilpin counties.

Slash collection sites are also open in Clear Creek and Jefferson Counties.

Sites are accepting pine beetle-infested wood, though some will cease accepting this wood during beetle flight season – generally from mid-July to September.
